## Re: Charter Challenge - Bill C-10

This will confirm that on the morning of Friday December 7<sup>th</sup>, we appeared before Ontario Superior Court Case Management Justice Campbell to update the Court with the various steps that the parties have agreed to in completion of this matter.

These steps include the date for delivery of the Attorney General's section 1 Reply Affidavits, cross examinations on all *Expenditure Restraint* Act Affiants, most particularly, on our side, Steve Jelly, dates for filing Applicant and Respondent facta as well as hearing dates. The Court has endorsed the proposed steps in completion of this matter and we will be presenting a draft Consent Order which will apply to both the PSAC's and PIPSC's Applications.

It is agreed that both Applications will be heard together. In addition, and importantly, we have been able to secure a hearing date before the Court which has been fixed for the entire week of October 21, 2013.

We will continue to keep you advised as this matter is concluded. In the meantime, do not hesitate to contact the undersigned in the event that you have any questions.
