Get ready to vote on **October 19, 2015**



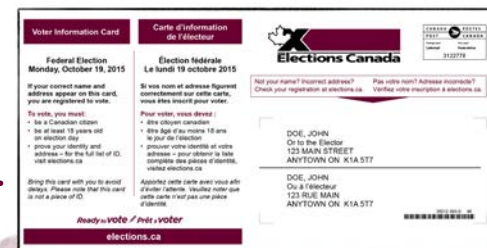
Go to **elections.ca** to get ready to vote:

September 25

Voter information cards are mailed to every registered voter.



September 30

Visit **elections.ca** to find the candidates in your riding.

Go to an Elections Canada office if you want to vote early.

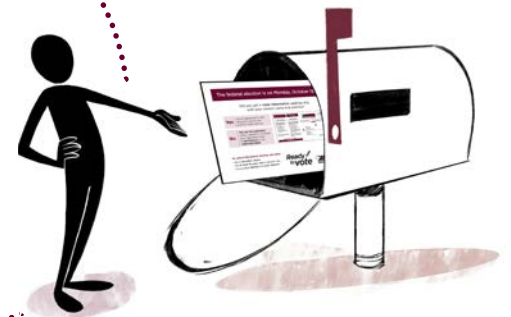
October 2

If your voter information card hasn't come in the mail, you may not be registered. Go to **elections.ca** to check or call **1-800-463-6868**.

October 7

An election reminder brochure has been mailed to all households.

Keep it handy – it has the full list of accepted ID.



October 9 to 12

Advance polling places are open for 4 days. For hours and locations: check your voter information card or **elections.ca**.

October 13

6:00 p.m. is the deadline for applying to vote by mail or at an Elections Canada office.

Election day!

Remember:

- Bring your ID.
- If you haven't registered yet, you can do so at your polling place.
